

Program Overview

The IH Vancouver Pathway Program is designed to give you the language and cultural skills needed to succeed in North American universities or colleges.

When you enter the Pathway Program, and meet the required English level, you will study in the English for Academic Purposes (EAP) Course. (Followed by an IELTS Preparation course if required.)

When you successfully complete the program, you will finish with the ability to write, speak and listen at a level acceptable for academic studies in Canada.

English for Academic Purposes consists of three levels



12 weeks/20 EAP lessons + 10 elective lessons per week

The Master's Academic Foundations Program at International House Vancouver prepares international students for studies in Canadian universities' graduate schools. Students will learn how to communicate effectively and collaborate by developing academic literacy skills, including reading, writing, speaking, and listening. These skills are essential for participating effectively in master's level educational programs.

- Critically read and analyze academic literature and employ effective reading and summary strategies.
- Effectively communicate orally at a sufficient level to participate in graduatelevel discourse, seminars, and presentations.
- Collaborate with fellow students to produce and contribute to team-based research projects.
- Conduct academic research, synthesize ideas, and produce academic written texts on their area of study, showing awareness of different ideas and contexts.
- Acquire and develop a repertoire of graduate-level study academic skills that can be applied to a wide range of graduate-level studies.



Program Aims

Students must be of a B1 (Intermediate) level or higher.

Students must take an Online placement test before the program. If they are below level, they should be directed towards General English classes until they achieve the minimum level of English.



Accommodation

We want our students to feel at home during their stay in Vancouver and take particular care in choosing suitable accommodation options. We offer two types of accommodation:





Co-living & other accommodations

IH Vancouver has options for independent and co-living accommodations in houses and apartments/hotels.

Co-living points:

- · Available to students over 19 years of age.
- Offers independent living by sharing an entire house with other students.
- Both private and shared rooms are available.
- Kitchen, bathroom and laundry facilities are shared
- Meals are not included
- Bed linens are provided but students should bring their own towel.
- Internet, TV and telephone service all included
- Minimum 3 month stay.





Homestay (13 years or older)

Our homestays are carefully selected and located in safe and pleasant residential neighbourhoods. Homestay accommodation gives students the chance to participate in some of the family life, experience a different culture and most of all, practice their English skills at home.

It typically takes between 20 to 50 minutes to get to and from the school by public transit.

Homestay points:

- A private room with a bed, desk and storage
- Half-board (breakfast and dinner)






